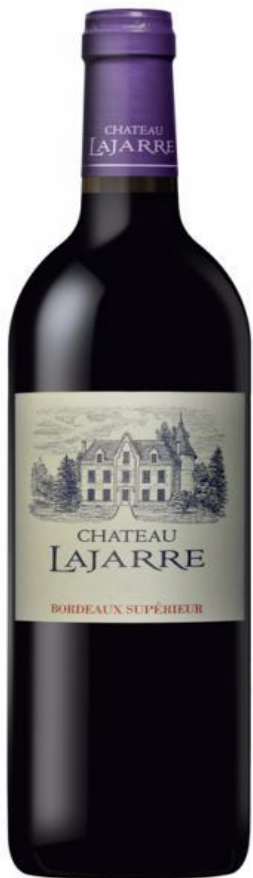




Château Lajarre 2016 AOC BORDEAUX SUPERIEUR

It was in 2005 that Dr. Grégory Lovato, a young doctor then aged 29, decided to take over the management of Château Lajarre, which belongs to his grandparents and to make it a name that counts in the appellation Bordeaux Supérieur .



Appellation : AOC BORDEAUX SUPERIEUR

Area : 32 HA

Middle Age of the vineyard : 25 years

Composition of the vineyard : 80% Merlot, 20 % Carbernet Franc

Soils Types : sandy, gravel, clay and limestone

Aging : Staineless steel tank and oak barrel

Tasting Notes : A limpid dress, intense red. The rather discreet nose at first sight is revealed with time. The aromas of black fruit and vanilla are complemented by a floral tip. The palate is expressive, frank with a tannic and aromatic structure.

Food/ wine pairing : red meat, cheese
